## **Our Theme**

Our theme for Autumn 1 is "Celebrations".

Have a look below at how we will be learning about celebrations across our curriculum!







In My Communication, we will be exploring key letters and words linked to the celebration of Halloween. We will be learning to recognise the symbols and signs for certain key words linked to this celebration also. We will be extending our repertoire of play skills so that we can learn how to role-play in our "Halloween Costume shop". We can't wait to read our new story: "We're going on a Pumpkin Hunt"! We will be working on reading, writing and communication and interaction ALIs across the timetable.



## The World about Me

In The World about Me, we will be exploring different celebrations through learning about festivals, traditions, cultures and different types of foods. We will teach the children independent skills through our weekly café visits, including a focus on travel training. We will be practising our dressing skills when attending our swimming lesson weekly this half term.



In My Community, we will be growing our independence in travel around the school and local community. We will be learning to walk safely with adults into Chorley town centre and visiting a different Café each week. We will learn routines e.g. when paying for items, and we will practise exchanging coins for food/drinks in real life! In school, we will be developing our social skills across the curriculum.



In My Thinking and Problem Solving, we will be learning about how people celebrate with food, including focusing on learning about capacity.

We will be learning about number through activities linked to our Halloween Celebrations topic.

We will be using money in our pretend costume shop and learning how to give a coin in exchange for a costume. The children will be encouraged to start to work on identifying coins through this regular role-play. We will be working on number and cognition and learning ALIs across the timetable.



In Me and My Body, we will be taking part in lots of physical activities across the timetable. In our PE lessons, we will be focusing on Dance and Gymnastics. In PSHE, we will be learning about how we can manage our feelings and we will be covering a topic in Sex and Relationships Education called 'Knowing Me'.



This half term, the children will be learning to develop a range of actions and movements to explore the world around them. They will be working together to combine actions and movements to make dances, based on the theme 'Celebrations'. They will learn to communicate, with help, about their own work and that of others, recognising some differences.
