In My Communication we will be focusing on Information Texts, Science Fiction stories and Space Poetry. We will be continuing to practise daily functional words and reading daily. We will also be practising our hand writing across the school day.

We will be practising our communication skills when out on weekly community visits.

We will be working on reading, writing and communication and interaction ALI's across the timetable.



In My Thinking and Problem Solving we will be learning to develop our number skills, 2D and 3D shapes and properties of shape. In Design Technology we will be working on making our own rockets.

We will be working on number and cognition and learning ALI's across the timetable.



The World about Me

In The World about Me, we will be learning about the earth and beyond and space.

We will be using our ipads to create fact files about earth and space and learning to use technology across the whole of school.



In Me and My Body, we will be taking part in lots of physical activity across the timetable including sensory regulation, riding bikes and playing on the playground equipment. We will be learning dance and gymnastics throughout the term.

We will be thinking about our mental health and how we can manage our feelings through using the zones of regulation. We will also be focusing on learning about personalised personal care and looking after our hygiene.



In My Community, we will be growing our independence in travel around the school and local community. We will be learning to walk safely with adults into Chorley town centre and developing our functional skills in café's and parks. We will also be learning about personal care, hygiene and taking care of our clothing.

In RE we will be learning all about the circle of life from birth to passing on.



In My Creativity, we will be exploring the life of an astronaut and learning all about the story of the hidden figures. They will be learning all about these aspects through dance and drama throughout the term.
