#### **Our Theme**



Our theme for Spring 1 is "Homes and Habitats".

## My Communication

In My Communication we will be exploring Homes and Habitats through different texts such as Three Little Pigs and This is Our House . We will be learning to recognise the words, symbols and signs for key words within these texts. We will also be extending our vocabulary with functional words, signs and symbols.

We will be working on reading, writing and communication and interaction ALI's across the timetable.



### **My Thinking and Problem Solving**

In My Thinking and Problem Solving we will be learning about number, length and time.

We will use these skills functionally across the school day, for example measurement in cooking and outdoor school, following our daily timetable and ordering daily routines both at home and at school.

We will be working on number and cognition and learning ALI's across the timetable.



#### The World about Me

In The World about Me, we will be exploring a variety of homes and habitats across themed weeks.

We will continue to work on our independence skills: practising our dressing and undressing skills for PE and swimming and practicing our travel training skills with trips to the park and the library.



In Me and My Body, we will be taking part in lots of physical activities across the timetable including sensory circuits, riding bikes and playing on the playground equipment. We will be practicing invasions games in PE. We will be thinking about parts of the body and which are public or private, and we will be learning about personal care and hygiene.

# My Community

In My Community, we will be growing our independence in travel around the school and local community. We will be learning to walk safely with adults to the library and the park.

In school, we will be developing our social skills and learning to play with each other.



In My Creativity, we will be creating lots of different paint based art and exploring different ways to use paint. We will practice our fine motor skills by printing and painting to make beautiful creations and
