Working thumb hand (palm down, pointing forward) moves down to strike supporting flat hand (palm up, pointing in).




Working little finger hand (palm back, pointing in) strikes twice against supporting palm.

INDIVIDUAL


Working index (palm back, point-ing up) is held between thumb and fingers of supporting parallel bent hand (palm in, pointing forward); working hand moves down and makes a short movement forwards.

VOICE



Working "V" hand (palm back/down, pointing back/up) taps throat and moves firmly forward.


RESPECT




Working index hand points to side of temple; then closed hands (palms in, pointing forward) held together make two short movements forwards/down maintaining contact. Directional sign.




BRITISH VALUES



Open hands (palms down, pointing forward) make two sharp downward movements; then open hands (palm back, pointing in) held against body, working hand above. Repeat.



Open pinched hands (palms forward, pointing up) move back to signer, alternately becoming closed pinched hands; then make letter shape "G"; formation makes sharp upward movement.

Working clawed hand (palm back, pointing up) taps several times against chin. Use appropriate facial expression.


Working index hand (palm back, pointing in) moves firmly down to rest on supporting flat hand (palm up, pointing forward).
