Learning Activities

This year pupils will study the core subjects of English, Math's and Computing. These subjects will be differentiated and lead to accreditation in the OCR Functional Skills Award or contribute to the ASDAN Personal Progress Award.



Our first English theme will be '**Celebrities**'. This will see pupils explore what makes someone a celebrity and practice creating persuasive texts such as adverts and blogs.



In Math's we will work on developing pupils understanding of number and the primary functions of addi-

tion, subtraction, multiplication and division. Opportunities will be given for pupils to apply these skills practically and in the community.



Computing will see pupils explore different types of computer hardware and operating systems. To support and consolidate the pupils knowledge of computing and its uses we will rehearse digital literacy skills in a range of subjects.



Our Science theme; The Human Body will give pupils the opportunity to learn about the key systems of the body: blood system,

respiratory system and the digestive system. Prior knowledge from the Year 10 topic '**Organs of the Body**' will be consolidated in this unit and all the work will support pupils in the first of the AQA Science assessments in Autumn 2.



The ASDAN theme will be linked to Healthy Living.

This will involve pupils looking at the board range of routines and activities required to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Pupils will look at how exercise, diet and hygiene can contribute to their own health and fitness.

Other Curriculum Activities

Food Technology skills will continue to be developed and our theme will be Food Handling, Preparation, Storage & Designing and Making a Healthy Snack.

During PE this half term pupils will engage in Invasion Games and will develop their skills and understanding of Handball. The sessions are every Tuesday afternoon so please ensure your child brings their PE kit.
