The curriculum was re-developed and launched in September 2014 in response to national agenda reform and internal self-evaluation.

The objectives of the National Curriculum 2014 are mapped across classes to ensure pupils have time to gain the relevant knowledge and understanding of what is being taught and have opportunities to participate in groups to achieve targets from their statement objectives.

All classes have extension objectives from the National Curriculum documentation should more able pupils require being challenged.

The Primary Department have a two year rolling programme and therefore have documentation labelled Year A and Year B this is due to the settings 'Stage not Age' approach to classes.

The subjects that are mapped on the 'Long Term Planning' in this way are:

Jones (2009) explains:

'The National Curriculum is not the school curriculum; it is the basic entitlement for pupils and lays out the minimum requirements of what should be taught. The power that school have to create and devise their own curriculum that incorporates that basic entitlement has always been there though not always used in terms of the potential for school leaders to decide how best to meet their pupils' learning needs'.

Religious Education

Religious Education has been mapped across the school using the 'Equals Scheme of Work'.

Physical Education

Physical Education has been mapped across the school using the 'Lancashire Scheme of Work'. This has been mapped against the classes in the same year groups as the table above.

Pupils also access swimming lessons and may take part in additional physical education as part of their statement objectives.

PHSCE

Personal, Health, Social, Citizenship Education has been mapped across the school using the 'Lancashire Scheme of Work'. This has been mapped against the classes in the same year groups as the table above.

Online Safety

Online Safety has been mapped across the curriculum with recommendations from the dedicated Online Safety Team at South West Grid for Learning Digital Literacy materials.

This has been mapped against the classes in the same year groups as the table above.

Modern Foreign Languages

Modern Foreign Languages has been mapped across the school using the 'Equals Scheme of Work'. This also has accreditation to support specific units of work.

Personal Learning Targets

Personal Learning Targets have been mapped across the school and have been developed from objectives on B Squared.

Cooking & Nutrition

In addition to the elements of this subject being taught through Design and Technology, Cooking and Nutrition is mapped out across the school to ensure each class accesses one lesson per week.

Phonics

Phonics is taught using the 'Jolly Phonics' Programme in Beech class and Sounds Write across the rest of the school. Pupils are assessed using the Sounds Write assessments to determine their level.

Wave 2 Provision

In addition to pupils working on objectives from their EHCP across the curriculum they also have access to a Teaching Assistant for individual or group support.

The targets for these interventions are mapped in the schools format and revised and up dated if necessary every term.

Wave 3 Provision

For pupils who require extensive additional support they are timetabled into the Pupil Additional Support Group (PALS) where they receive specialised interventions and activities.
